Road Traffic Acts

Conwy County Borough Council

TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14(1) AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

THE COUNTY BOROUGH OF CONWY (GLAN Y MOR ROAD, DEGANWY) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2002

Notice is hereby given that the Conwy County Borough Council intend not less than 21 days from the date hereof to make an Order, the effect of which will be:

1. To prohibit any person from causing any vehicle proceeding in the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this notice and in the direction specified in Column 2, to make a turning manoeuvre specified in Column 3.

2. To prohibit any vehicle to wait, load or unload at any time in the length of road specified in Schedule 2 hereto.

The Order is necessary to facilitate the Deganwy Marina development by Lifetime Projects (2001) Ltd.

The Order comes into effect on the day it is made and shall continue in force for an indefinite period until the Marina development is completed, at which time it will be revoked. The anticipated duration of the Order is 30 months.
