ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A6 TRUNK ROAD (CLAPHAM BYPASS, BEDFORDSHIRE) (24 HOURS CLEARWAY) ORDER 200

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order, under sections 1(1), 2(1), (2) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on the A6 Trunk Road, at Clapham in Bedfordshire.

The effect of the Order would be to prohibit any vehicle from waiting at any time on the A6 Trunk Road, Clapham Bypass, other than a layby, between points 370 metres north of its junction with Shakespeare Road,

Bedford and 780 metres north of the bridge carrying Highfield Road, Oakley (C46), or on any of the slip roads leading to or from that length of road.

A copy of the proposed Order, a plan illustrating the proposals and a statement of the Secretary of State's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected, during normal office hours, at the offices of URS Thorburn Colquhoun, 200 Harpur Centre, Horne Lane, Bedford MK40 1TS; Bedford Borough Council, Town Hall, St Paul's Square, Bedford MK40 1SJ; or obtained by application to the Highways Agency, Operations Division, PPD Orders Team, Heron House, 49-53 Goldington Road, Bedford MK40 3LL, quoting Ref HA 41/2/34.

Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order should write to the Highways Agency at the above address stating the grounds of objection not later than 15 July 2002.
