Madrid, August 22.

N the 18th Instant arrived an Express from the Marquels de Lede, with Letters duted the 24th of July, glving an Account, that on the 23d he caused his Infantry to be landed between Metazzo and Messinal without any Opposition, the Cavalry joining them the same Day. That then the Army advancing towards Messing two Piemontese Battallions: which were at a Post called the Capuchins, quitted it and retired into the Citadel and Forts Whereupon the Inhabitants of Messina fer open the Gates of the City, land admitted the Spaniards with great Acclaimations of Joy. On the 18th Instant marched from hence a Detachment of 100 Life, Guards for Catalonia; and other Troops quartered in several Parts of Castile, are, ordered to march thither likewise, upon the presfing Instances ('tis faid) of the Governour of Castel-Rodrigo, Governour of that Principality.
