

Madrid, September 5. E have Advice from Cadiz, that the Intendant Sig. Varas having Information privately given him, that a confiderable Sum in Pieces of Eight was concealed on board the Admiral of the Flota, and had not been rer gistred, he caused strict Search to be made, and it was found and siezed. This having alarmed feveral Perfons who had unregistred Silver concealed on board the Flota, they went before the proper Officer at Cadiz, and declared the Value of what they had fo concealed, defiring to be allowed to pay the fame Indulto for it as for the registred Ef-There has been another Infurfects. rection of the Populace at the Havana: The Occasion was this, The General of the Flota fent Order to the Bishop of that Place to imbark for Spain, to give an Account of his Behaviour in the Time of the Commotion railed there laft Year, when the Farm of Tobacco was defigned to be established for the King's Account. But the Council, as alfo the new Governour and the Officers, interceeding that the Bishop might not be carried off till his Majesty's Pleafure were further known, he was allowed to flay, and the People returned to their Obedience. The President of the Crusada is put at the Head of the Tribunal of the Inquisition, to supply the Room of the Inquisitor-General Molines during his Confinement. 'Tis faid the Marquels of Pozzobueno, who was Governour of Portolongone, is nominated by his Catholick Majefty to go to Sweden, as his Minister and Plenipotentiary.

Venice, Sept. 9. Sig. Diedo being chofen Dean of the Lucal Church of St. Mark, made his publick Entry on the 5th Inftant, and took Poffession of that Dig-nity. The same Day came in a Man of War, having on board General Sala and other Officers, who came from Corfu. On Wednesday arrived a Ship in 18 Days from Corfu, the Master of which reports, that the Day before his, Departure one of the largest Spanish Men of War, and another of the third Rate, came into that Port. We have Advice from Zant, that the Fleet of this Republick was arrived there, and that Iome of the Ships were pretty much damaged in the Engagement with the Turks, in which about a Thousand Men were loft on our Side : The fame Letters fay, that the Turkish Fleet having been much shattered in that Engagement, had put into the Bay of Coron to refit. Sig Ruzzini, who affifted in the Congress at Passarowitz, as Ambassadour Plenipotentiary of this State, is nominated by the Senate to go Ambaffadour Extraordinary to the Ottoman Porte.

Vienna, Sept. 10. Sir Robert Sutton, the King of Great Britain's Ambaffedour for the Mediation of the Peace concluded at Paffarowitz, arrived here Yefterday: He came from Paffarowitz on the 24th, having been prefent on the 21ft at the Exchange of the Ratifications of the Treaties between the Emperour, the Republick of Venice, and the Grand Signior. Count Colliers, the Minister-Mediatour on the Part of the States General, who was also prefent at the Exchanging of the faid Ratifications, fet
