**T**HIS Morning at Seven a-Clock the Emperess was brought to Bed of an Archdutchess, Infanta of Spain, &c. which will be baptized this Evening, and Prince Eugene of Savoy is to be God-father. The Court has received by an Express, Letters from the Viceroy of Naples dated the 3d of this Month, with Advice, that Count Staremberg, Nephew of the Field-Marshal and Lieutenant-Colonel of his Regiment, had reinforced the Piemontese Garrisons of the Citadel of Messina and Fort St. Salvador with some German Troops: And that there was Advice from Sicily, that most of the Inhabitants appeared ready to declare for the Emperour, finding they were like to be soon brought under his Dominion. The Procurator Sig. Ruzzini, who assisted at the Congress of Passarowitz, in the Quality of Ambassadour Plenipotentiary of the Republick of Venice, arrived here on the 11th Instant. The Report continues, that the Count de Virmond is to go to reside at Constantinople, with the Character of the Emperour's Ambassadour; and that the first Ambassadour of the Ottoman Porte at the Congress of Passarowitz, is to come to reside here on the Part of the Grand Signior. Letters from Transylvania relate, That the Grand Signior had ordered a considerable Body of Troops to march towards the Ukraine, and that the Cham of the Tartars was expected at Adrianople, to assist at a great Divan. 'Tis said the Ottoman Porte insist on the Departure of the Russian Troops out of Poland, and on the Execution of the 5th Article of the Treaty of Pruth.

*in Bernae, Sept. 21.* On the 13th Instant the Abbot of St. Gall received the Homage of the People of Tockembourg, who were assembled in common to the Number of Eleven Thousand Four Hun-

dred Heads, from the Age of Fourteen to Seventy. The Abbot came in Person to the Assembly with a Train of 400 Horse, and returned the same Day to Weyl, where he has since settled his Officers throughout the whole Extent of his Dominions. On the 16th Instant the Sovereign Council met to adjourn themselves for a Month on Account of the Vintage Season, which according to Custom causes a Recess from all manner of Business here. They write from Milan of the 13th Instant, that they had received Advice from Turin, that the Marquis of St. Thomas, Chief Minister of that Court, who went lately to Vienna, was to proceed from thence to Paris and the Hague, in order to solicit the Admission of the King, his Master into the Quadruple Alliance. The same Letters add, that Part of the Regiment of Berezeni was already at Mantua, where several other Regiments of Horse and Dragoons were likewise expected, in order to march into the Kingdom of Naples.

*Frankfort, Sept. 21.* The Landgrave of Hesse Cassel continues to remove what belongs to him out of the Fortress of Rhinsels, and 'tis expected his Troops will evacuate it forthwith, to make room for a Garrison of the Troops of the Circle. Some Advices from Italy say, That the Inhabitants of Sassari in Sardinia, upon the News of the Defeat of the Spanish Fleet, revolted and massacred the Garrison. That a Design was also formed against the Garrison of Cagliari, but the Governour getting Intelligence of it, prevented its being put in Execution.

*Brussels, Sept. 24.* The Night between the 22d and 23d Instant, 4 or 500 of the Rabble got together, and pulled down some Publick Houses near the Chappel of Notre-Dame. The Governour having Notice of this Commotion, immediately sent for Orders to the Marquess de Prié, who commanded him to call
