### Road Traffic Acts

#### *Corporation of London*

##### CHANGES TO ENTITLEMENTS FOR BLUE BADGE HOLDERS

1. Notice is hereby given that the Common Council of the City of London proposes to make Orders under sections 6 and 45 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The effect of the Orders would be to change the parking entitlements for blue badge holders in the City, so that:

(a) at metered and pay and display parking bays an additional hour of parking would be allowed without charge after the expiry of the period for which a parking charge has been paid; and

(b) parking at disabled persons' bays would be available at any time subject to a maximum period of three hours. The maximum permitted stay of six hours at the disabled persons' parking places in the vicinity of St Bartholomew's Hospital would remain unchanged.
