VIVE British, Ships, of War, which were fent in August to Port-Mahon to careen, arrived here on the 12th Inftant, and Sit George Byng has fince caufed them to put to Sea, with Orders to cruife in proper Stations on the Coaft of Sicily, to prevent the coming of Succours to the Spaniards. On the 11th Inftant, the remaining Part of the Tranfports with 2000 Germans from Genoa, urrived here: By contrary Winds and Weather they had been detained to long in their Paffage, that they wanted Provisions and Water; but having been supplied with all Refreshments, Sir George Byng appointed a Convoy to go with them for Melazzo, and they failed the right at Night; but to Day we received an Account, that they are put back by contrary Winds to Baia. On the 19th arrived General Wachtendonck from Melazzo, to confer with the Viceroy on the State of Affairs at that Place.

Berne, Jan. 4: M. Hogguer of Sr. Gall having been appointed by the King of Sweden, to be his Refident with the Proteftant Cantons, has prefented his Credential Letters to the Canton of Zufich, which have been communicated to this State, and to the reft of the Proceftant Cantons; and has acquainted them, that he will refide at Copet in the Pais de Vaud.
