THE BROMLEY (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) ORDER 2003

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Bromley, hereinafter called "the Council" on 18 December 2003, made the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9, to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of, and Part I of Schedule 5 to, the Local Government Act 1985 and of all other enabling powers, which will come into operation on 1 January 2004.

The effect of the Order will be to revoke the provisions of The Bromley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1998 and reproduce those provisions without any change in substance.

A copy of the Order can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive for a period of 6 weeks from the date of making the Order at the Bromley Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Bromley, Kent.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act or that a requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with, may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

THE HAMMERSMITH AND FULHAM (DOCTOR PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 1) ORDER 2003

1. Notice is hereby given that on 24 December 2003, the Council of the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham has made the above Order under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic Act 1991.

2. The Order comes into operation on 3 January 2004 and its general effect will be as described in the notice of proposals published on 28 November 2003 in the Hammersmith and Fulham Gazette and the London Gazette.

3. For a period of 6 weeks from the day on which the Order is made, a copy of the Order and a copy of the Council's statement of reasons for making the Order can be inspected during normal office hours in the Traffic Group, Environment Department, Town Hall Extension, King Street, London W6 9JU.

4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or any of the provisions therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements or regulation has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks of the Order being made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

THE HILLINGDON (ON STREET PARKING PLACES) (UXBRIDGE ROAD) ORDER 2003

UXBRIDGE ROAD, HILLINGDON, SOUTH WEST SIDE, BETWEEN LEES ROAD AND NEW ROAD

Hillingdon Council gives notice that on 12 December 2003, it made these orders which will:

- (1) impose a bus lane as set out in the Schedule below;
- (2) impose waiting and loading restrictions as set out in the Schedule below;
- (3) provide parking places in which parking is permitted for a maximum of two hours with a charge of 20p per 20 minutes;
- (4) provide loading bays for goods vehicles only, for a maximum of 20 minutes for the purposes of loading and unloading;
- (5) provide a disabled person's parking bay in which only a vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge is permitted to park.

The above-mentioned parking places, loading bays and disabled bay will be operational between 9.00 am and 5.00 pm Monday to Friday, located on the south-west side of Uxbridge Road, between Westbourne Road and Lees Road.

Copies of the Orders which will come into operation on 2 February 2004, can be seen at Hayes End Library and at Level 3 reception, Civic Centre, Uxbridge, during normal office hours, for 6 weeks following the date on which this notice is published.
