THE GUILDFORD OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES ORDER 2004

Notice is hereby given that Guildford Borough Council has made an Order in exercise of its powers under sections 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), Regulation 21 and Part IV of Schedule 4 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 and the Road Traffic Act 1991 (as amended) whether generally or in relation to the Council's area and with the consent of Surrey County Council in accordance with section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act the effect of which will be to:

- revoke all previous off-street parking Orders on the date that the new Order comes into effect;
- implement effectively road traffic regulation enforcement consequent upon the decriminalisation of off-street parking offences by the designation of the Council's area as a special parking area by virtue of a statutory instrument designation Order entitled the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (County of Surrey) (Borough of Guildford) Order 2004; and
- in consequence of the above, the Council's parking attendants will have the ability to issue penalty charge notices for off-street parking contraventions of the above Order.

The Order will also have the effect of replacing the existing contract parking spaces at Bedford Road Sheds Car Park, Guildford with pay and display car parking on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays between the hours of 8.00 am to 6.00 pm with a charge of:

- 60p per hour or any part of an hour between the charging hours of 8.00 am to 6.00 pm on Saturdays and Bank Holidays; and
- £1 per visit between the charging hours of 11.00 am to 5.00 pm on Sundays.

NOTE. The Order will come into effect on 1 June 2004.

A copy of the Order may be inspected at Guildford Borough Council Offices, Millmead House, Millmead, Guildford on Mondays to Fridays between the hours of 9.00 am and 4.30 pm.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any other provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on any grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 28 May 2004 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
