ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACTS 1984 AND 1991

THE EAST SUSSEX (LEWES DISTRICT) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2004

Notice is hereby given that East Sussex County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), and 2(1) to (4), 3(2), 4(2), 32, 35(1) and (3), 45, 49, 51, 52, 53 and 63A of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) ("the Act"), as amended, and sections 43, and 63 to 79 inclusive and Schedule 3 to the Road Traffic

Act 1991(b) in connection with the forthcoming introduction of decriminalised parking throughout Lewes District.

The issuing of a £60 Fixed Penalty Notice, by a parking attendant, will apply where any vehicle is parked in contravention of a provision contained within the supporting Traffic Regulation Order.

A copy of the Traffic Regulation Order in draft form, plans showing the lengths of roads affected, statement of the County Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, and copies of old Orders consolidated into this one Order for ease of reference, may be examined in the main Reception Area, County Hall, Lewes, on Mondays to Fridays, between 9.00 am and 4.00 pm inclusive, at Lewes Library, Albion Street, on Mondays and Thursdays, 9.30 am and 7.00 pm, Tuesdays, 10.30 am to 5.00 pm, Wednesdays, 9.30 am to 1.00 pm, and on Fridays and Saturdays from 9.30 am to 5.00 pm. Copies can also be inspected at Haywards Heath Library, Boltro Road, on Mondays to Fridays, 9.30 am to 7.00 pm, or on Saturdays from 9.30 am to 5.00 pm, at the offices of Lewes District Council, Lewes House, 32 High Street, Lewes, Fort Road, Newhaven, or Seaford Town Council, Hurtis House, Broad Street, Seaford, during normal office hours.
