IR George Byng proposes to leave this Place the end of this Month, and to fail with some of the Men of War for Naples, leaving Orders för the reft to follow him as they get ready. To Day Sir George Byng difpatched the Dragon and Su-perbe to Gaptain Cavendifh, with Copies of his full Powers and Influctions from his Majefty, and with Orders and Power from himfelf to treat and fettle a Peace with the Moors. Captain Matthews of the Kent, who commands his Majefty's Squadron at Pentemelia near Reggio, has written a Letter to Sir At Pentemeila near Reggio, nas written a Letter to Sir George Byng, dated the 2d of February, adviling, that on the 29th of January the Royal Oak and Rochelter returned from cruiling, bringing with them a Spa-nish Man of War of 22 Guns and 180 Men called the Little St. John, which the Royal Oak took on the 26th; the left Messina the Night before with Common the 26th; and the Messina the Night before with Cammock, whom file was carrying to Malta, whence he was to proceed to Barcelona, but he efcaped by taking in time to his Boat, and making to Catania; he left behind him the Pretender's Com-mifion conflituting him Admiral of the White, to-gether with other Papers.
