COMMENCEMENT OF PROVISIONS OF THE MEDICAL ACT 1983 (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2002 (SI 2002/3135)

In accordance with Article 1(2) and (3) of the Medical Act 1983 (Amendment) Order 2002, the Department of Health hereby gives notice that the Secretary of State has specified 7 July 2004 as the day for the coming into force of the following provisions of the Medical Act 1983 (Amendment) Order 2002:

1. Article 2 in so far as it relates to paragraphs 2 to 11 below.
2. For the purpose only of making rules, Article 5(3) in so far as it relates to paragraphs 19A to 19E of Schedule 1 to the Act.

6. Article 13 in so far as it relates to section 35CC(1).
7. Article 13 in so far as it relates to section 43 of the Act in so far as it relates to paragraphs 1, 5A(1), (3), (3A) and (9), 6 and 7(3), (4) and (6) of Schedule 4 to the Act.
8. For the purpose only of making rules, Article 13 in so far as it relates to section 43 of the Act in so far as it relates to paragraph 5A(2) of Schedule 4 to the Act.
9. Article 14 in so far as it relates to paragraphs 1, 5A(1), (3), (3A) and (9), 6 and 7(3), (4) and (6) of Schedule 4 to the Act.
10. For the purpose only of making rules, Article 14 in so far as it relates to paragraph 5A(2) of Schedule 4 to the Act.
11. Article 15(6)(c) in so far as it relates to the definition of impaired.

INTEGRATED POLLUTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL

Notice is hereby given that Stephen Wood, of J & SA Wood, has applied to the Environment Agency for an Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control (IPPC) permit to operate an installation involving the landfilling of waste. The installation is located at Weights Farm Landfill Site, Weights Lane, Redditch, Worcestershire B97 6RG, in the Borough of Redditch in the county of Worcestershire.

The application contains a description of any foreseeable significant effects of emissions from the installation on the environment. Information relating to the above IPPC application for a permit to operate the Weights Farm Landfill is held in registers at the following locations:

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Take notice that J & B Farnaby of Brough Moor Turf Farm, Scurragh Lane, Skeeby, Richmond, North Yorks DL10 5EF, is applying to the Environment Agency for a licence to abstract water from a borehole in the carboniferous limestone at National Grid Ref N2 2158 0267 at Brough Moor Farm, Scurragh Lane, Skeeby in the parish of Brompton-on-Swale, Richmondshire district of North Yorkshire. The proposal is to abstract water at the following rates: 25 cubic metres per hour, 250 cubic metres per day, 40,000 cubic metres between 1 March and 31 October each year. The water will be used for spray irrigation. The annual quantity will be abstracted in aggregate with the annual quantity authorised to be abstracted from three other boreholes. This application seeks to replace an existing time limited licence which is due to expire on 31 October 2004. A copy of the application and any map, plans and other documents submitted with it may be inspected, free of charge at all reasonable hours at Brough Moor Farm, Scurragh Lane, Skeeby, Richmond, between 9 July and 9 August 2004.
