THE GREENWICH (PRESCRIBED ROUTES) (AMENDMENT NO) ORDER 200

THE GREENWICH (BUS LANES) (CONSOLIDATION) (AMENDMENT NO) TRAFFIC ORDER 200

THE GREENWICH (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO $\,$) ORDER 200

THE GREENWICH (FREE PARKING PLACES) (DISABLED PERSONS) (AMENDMENT NO) ORDER 200

- 1. Notice is hereby given that Greenwich Council, hereinafter called the Council, propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Prescribed Routes Order would be to:
- (a) impose one-way working on vehicles proceeding in the lengths of streets specified in column 1 to the table in Schedule 1 to this notice and in the direction specified in column 2 of that table;
- (b) impose one-way working from north-west to south-east on vehicles proceeding in that length of Westcombe Hill that extends between a point 61 metres east of the eastern kerbline of Combedale Road and the northern kerbline of Westerdale Road, except for buses proceeding in the contra-flow bus lane mentioned in paragraph 3a of this notice;

- (c) impose a no right turn restriction on vehicles proceeding in Blackwall Lane on reaching its junction with the A102 northbound exit slip road:
- (d) impose an ahead only restriction on vehicles proceeding northeastward in Blackwall Lane on reaching its junction with the A102 southbound exit slip road.
- 3. The general effect of the Bus Lane Order would be to:
- (a) designate a contra-flow bus lane operative at any time on the length of street specified in Schedule 2A to this notice;
- (b) designate a with-flow bus lane operative at any time on the length
- of street specified in Schedule 2B to this notice.

 4. The general effect of the Waiting and Loading Restriction Order would be to impose waiting and loading restrictions operative at any time on the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 3 to this notice.

Details of exemptions from the restrictions for certain vehicles and persons, together with restrictions on selling or advertising in a restricted street are contained in the original Order of 1994

5. The general effect of the Disabled Persons' Parking Places Order would be to further amend the Greenwich (Free Parking Spaces) (Disabled Persons) Order 1994, so as to designate disabled persons' parking places, specified in Schedule 4 to this notice, in which vehicles displaying a valid disabled person's badge may be left.

7. Copies of the proposed Orders, of the Orders being amended and a

plan showing the locations and effects of the Orders, together with the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders can be inspected, during normal office hours, on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made or as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Orders, at Greenwich Transportation and Highways, Strategic Planning Department, Greenwich Council, Peggy Middleton House, 50 Woolwich New Road, Woolwich, London SE18 6HQ.

Copies of the proposed Orders and a plan showing the locations can also be inspected at all local libraries.

Combedale Road: between the southern kerbline of Westerdale Road Generally and the southern kerbline of Westcombe Hill. south to north

Westcombe Hill: between the eastern kerbline of Combedale Road Generally west and a point 61 metres east of that kerbline. to east

Westerdale Road:

between the western kerbline of Westcombe Hill Generally east and the eastern kerbline of Combedale Road. to west

Westcombe Hill, the south-west side, from the northern kerbline of Westerdale Road to a point 61 metres east of the eastern kerbline of Combedale Road, including the slip road giving access to Blackwall Tunnel Southern Approach northbound exit slip road leading to Woolwich Road.

Blackwall Lane, the west side, from a point 16 metres north of the northeastern kerbline of the A102 northbound on-slip from Blackwall Lane extending north-eastward for a distance of 65 metres.

SCHEDULE 3

Westcombe Hill, both sides, between a point 61 metres east of the eastern kerbline of Combedale Road and a point 25 metres south-east of the southern kerbline of Westerdale Road.

Annandale Road, the south-east side of the north-east to south-west arm, from a point 0.4 metres south-west of the party wall of Nos 28 and 30 Annadale Road extending north-eastward for a distance of 6 metres.

Calvert Road, the south-east side of the north-east to south-west arm. from a point opposite the party wall of Nos 46 and 48 Calvert Road extending south-westward for a distance of 6 metres.
