Food Standards Agency—Agency Warns Consumers About Chicken Contaminated With A Banned Veterinary Medicine The Food Standards Agency is advising people not to eat certain batches of fresh organic free range chicken found to contain traces of a nitrofurans, a banned veterinary medicine. The affected products comprise both whole birds and chicken pieces, which are sold under the brand names Moy Park, Tesco, Waitrose and Morrisons. Up to 23 tonnes of affected chicken has been distributed across the UK
