Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred on Local Authorities' by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and in accordance with regulation 23 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996, Transport for London has made The Lewisham Local Road (A2) Red Route Traffic Order 2000 Variation Order 2004 ("the permanent Order"). That Order will come into force on 5 November 2004, and the effect of that Order will be to continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the experimental Orders.

5. The road affected by the permanent Orders is the A2 New Cross Road in the London Borough of Lewisham.

6. A copy of the permanent Order, a map indicating the location and effect of the Order and a copy of the experimental Orders and any other Order varied, revoked or suspended by the permanent Order can be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of:

Any person wishing to question the validity of the permanent Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which that Order is made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
