ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A40 TRUNK ROAD (OLD BATH ROAD, CHELTENHAM) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2004

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he made this Order on 27 October 2004, coming into force on 8 November 2004, on the A40 Trunk Road, in the borough of Cheltenham in the county of Gloucestershire. The notice of the proposal to make it (Ref HA 041/029/159) was published in issue No 57397 of *The London Gazette*, on 1 September 2004, and the effect of the Order is as described in that notice. The existing Experimental Order will be revoked. Copies of the made Order, of a plan illustrating the Order and of the Experimental Order to be revoked may be inspected during normal

Any person aggrieved by the Order and wishing to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks from 27 October 2004 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or any provision contained therein.
