1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the following Orders under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985:

The Kingston upon Thames (Width Restriction) (No) Traffic Order 200 :

The Kingston upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) (Amendment No /200) Traffic Order 200 .

2. The general effect of the Orders would be to:

(a) introduce a width restriction in Oakleigh Way, Tolworth applying to vehicles exceeding 7 feet (2.13 metres) in width. The restriction would
