

(i) at any time throughout the week in those streets or lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;

(ii) between 7.00 am and 7.00 pm Monday to Saturday inclusive, in those lengths of Linden Avenue and Chipstead Valley Road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;

(iii) between 9.00 am and 5.00 pm Monday to Saturday inclusive, in those lengths of St Paul's Road specified in Schedule 3 to this notice.

3. The prohibition referred to in paragraph 2(b) above would not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, eg the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc, from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Badge" will apply.

4. A copy of the proposed Order, of the Croydon (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2001 (and of the Orders which have amended that Order), of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order, and of a map which indicates the lengths of roads to which the proposed restrictions relate can be inspected until the last day of a period of 6 weeks beginning with the date on which the Order is made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Order, during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, at the Enquiry Counter, "One Stop" Facility, Taberner House, Park Lane, Croydon Surrey.

Persons desiring to object to the proposed Order should send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Order Making Section, Parking and Departmental Support Services, Environmental, Cultural and Sports Services Department, 1st Floor, Davis House, Robert Street, Croydon CRO 1QQ, quoting the Ref ECSS/PM/JH/7/Z13, by 27 July 2005.

7. The proposed Order is intended to introduce "At any time" waiting restrictions in lengths of Brampton Road, Bredon Road, Dartnell Road, Davidson Road, Dominion Road, Edward Road, Exeter Road, Fullerton Road, Kemerton Road, Laurier Road, Morland Road, Overbury Crescent, Pawsons Road, Queen's Road, Rymer Road, St Saviour's Road, Sandfield Road and Station Road, Kenley, and between 7.00 am and 7.00 pm Monday to Saturday inclusive, in Chipstead Valley Road and Linden Avenue. In a length of St Paul's Road waiting restrictions between 9.00 am and 5.00 pm Monday to Saturday inclusive, would be introduced. The restrictions in Morland Road at its junction with Dartnell Road are to be reduced in length outside Nos 99 to 103 Morland Road, but the hours of operation increased to "At any time" for the remaining waiting restrictions. This is to improve visibility for motorists emerging from junctions, that pedestrians crossing minor roads can see and be seen and reduce obstructive parking so that turning vehicles have sufficient manoeuvrability.

SCHEDULE 1

Brampton Road, Croydon:

(a) from the south-eastern kerbline of Davidson Road south-eastward for a distance of 10 metres;

(b) the north-west and south-west sides,

(i) from a point 4 metres south-west of the north-eastern flank wall of No 33 Brampton Road to the party wall of Nos 33 and 35 Brampton Road;

(ii) from its junction with Dartnell Road to a point 4 metres north-west of the south-eastern flank wall of No 95 Edward Road;

(c) the south-east side, from the north-eastern kerbline of Dartnell Road north-eastward for a distance of 10 metres.

Bredon Road, Croydon, from the north-eastern kerbline of Dartnell Road north-eastward for a distance of 10 metres.

Dartnell Road, Croydon:

(a) from the north-western kerbline of Morland Road north-westward for a distance of 10 metres;

(b) the north-east side,

(i) from a point 10 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerbline of Kemerton Road and a point 10 metres north-west of the north-western kerbline of Kemerton Road;

(ii) from a point 10 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerbline of Bredon Road and a point 10 metres north-west of the north-western kerbline of Bredon Road;

(iii) from a point 10 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerbline of Laurier Road and a point 10 metres north-west of the north-western kerbline of Laurier Road;

(iv) from a point 10 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerbline of Dominion Road and a point 10 metres north-west of the north-western kerbline of Dominion Road;

(v) from the south-eastern kerbline of Brampton Road south-eastward for a distance of 10 metres;

(c) the south-west side,

(i) from a point 10 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerbline of Fullerton Road and a point 10 metres north-west of the north-western kerbline of Fullerton Road;

(ii) from a point 10 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerbline of Exeter Road and a point 10 metres north-west of the north-western kerbline of Exeter Road;

(iii) from a point 10 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerbline of Rymer Road and a point 10 metres north-west of the north-western kerbline of Rymer Road;

(iv) from a point 10 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerbline of Edward Road and its junction with Dartnell Road.

Davidson Road, Croydon, the south-east side, from a point 10 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerbline of Brampton Road to a point 10 metres south-west of the south-western kerbline of Brampton Road.

Dominion Road, Croydon, from the north-eastern kerbline of Dartnell Road north-eastward for a distance of 10 metres.

Edward Road, Croydon, from the south-western kerbline of Dartnell Road south-westward for a distance of 10 metres.

Exeter Road, Croydon, from the south-western kerbline of Dartnell Road south-westward for a distance of 10 metres.

Fullerton Road, Croydon, from the south-western kerbline of Dartnell Road south-westward for a distance of 10 metres.

Kemerton Road, Croydon, from the north-eastern kerbline of Dartnell Road north-eastward for a distance of 10 metres.

Laurier Road, Croydon, from the north-eastern kerbline of Dartnell Road north-eastward for a distance of 10 metres.

Morland Road, Croydon, the north-west side, between a point 10 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerbline of Dartnell Road and a point 20 metres south-west of the south-western kerbline of Dartnell Road.

Overbury Crescent, New Addington:

(a) the north-west to south-east arm, from the common boundary of Nos 61 and 63 Overbury Crescent to the common boundary of Nos 86 and 88 Overbury Crescent;

(b) the north-east to south-west arm, from its junction with the north-west to south-east arm of Overbury Crescent to the party wall of Nos 71 and 73 Overbury Crescent.

Pawsons Road, Thornton Heath, from the north-eastern kerbline of Queen's Road north-eastward for a distance of 48 metres.

Queen's Road, Thornton Heath:

(a) from a point 3 metres south-east of the party wall of Nos 133 and 135 Queen's Road to the common boundary of Nos 141 and 143 Queen's Road;

(b) the south-west side, from the north-western kerbline of St Saviours Road north-westward for a distance of 10 metres.

Rymer Road, Croydon, from the south-western kerbline of Dartnell Road south-westward for a distance of 10 metres.

St Saviour's Road, Thornton Heath, the north-west side, from the south-western kerbline of Queen's Road south-westward for a distance of 10 metres.

Sandfield Road, Thornton Heath, from the south-western kerbline of Parchmore Road south-westward for a distance of 10 metres.

Station Road, Kenley, the south-west side, from a point 15 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerbline of Hayes Lane to a point 10 metres south-east of a point opposite the common boundary of Nos 7 and 8 Station Cottages, Station Road.

SCHEDULE 2

Chipstead Valley Road, Coulsdon, the north-west side, between the south-western boundary of No 336 Chipstead Valley Road and a point 10 metres south-west of the south-western kerbline of Linden Avenue.

Linden Avenue, Coulsdon, from the north-western kerbline of Chipstead Valley Road north-westward for a distance of 10 metres.

SCHEDULE 3

St Paul's Road, Thornton Heath:

(a) the north-west side, between a point opposite the party wall of Nos 30 and 32 St Paul's Road and a point 4 metres south-west of the south-western boundary of No 25 St Paul's Road;
