THE EALING (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION)
(SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (AMENDMENT NO) ORDER 200
LEELAND TERRACE

1. Notice is hereby given, that the London Borough of Ealing Council propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
2. The general effect of the Order would be to permit taxis to wait at the cab rank in the length of Leeland Terrace specified in the Schedule to this notice between 7.00 am and 10.00 pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive and between 10.00 am and 4.00 pm on Sundays.

The Order, and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order, are available for inspection between 9.00 am and 5.00 pm, Mondays to Fridays inclusive, at Mouchel Parkman, 22-24 Uxbridge Road, Ealing, London W5 2BP, until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Order is made or the Council decides not to make the Order.

PROPOSAL TO DESIGNATE NEW DISABLED PERSONS'
PARKING PLACES AND REVOKE EXISTING DISABLED
PERSONS' PARKING PLACES

(This notice is about the Council's proposal to designate new disabled persons' parking places in certain roads in the borough and to remove certain disabled persons' parking places that are no longer required in the borough. Objections may be made—see paragraph 6.)

1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth propose to make the Lambeth (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No) Order 2005 under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. In brief, the general effect of the Order would be to:

- (a) designate new disabled persons' parking places on the streets specified in Schedule 1 to this notice; and
- (b) revoke disabled persons' parking places on the streets specified in Schedule 2 to this notice (this will enable the Council to remove certain disabled bays that are no longer required).
