##### *London Borough of Brent*

##### **THE BRENT (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO ) ORDER 200**

1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Brent propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of, and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to, the Local Government Act 1985.

2. The general effect of the Order would be further to amend the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that:

- (a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited at any time in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- (b) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited between 8.00 am and 6.30 pm, Mondays to Saturdays, in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;
- (c) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place would be prohibited between 11.00 am and 6.30 pm
