# CLERKENWELL ROAD AND OLD STREET BUS LANE AMENDMENTS

- 1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of The London Borough of Islington proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
- 2. The general effect of the Bus Priority Order would be to further amend the Islington (Bus Priority) Consolidation Order 2004 to bring it in line with the on-street layout and so that:
- (a) the south-west bound bus lane on Clerkenwell Road, between a point 10 metres south-west of the party wall of Nos 39 to 43 and 45/47 Clerkenwell Road and a point 1 metre north-east of the party wall of Nos 57 to 61 and 63 Clerkenwell Road, the hours of operation would be amended to 7.00 am to 7.00 pm Mondays to Fridays and 8.00 am to 1.30 pm on Saturdays; and
- (b) the south-west bound bus lane on Old Street, between a point opposite the party wall of Nos 188 to 194 and 196 Old Street and a point 1.5 metres south-west of the party wall of Nos 76/78 and 80 to 86 Old Street, the hours of operation would be amended to 7.00 am to 10.00 am and 4.00 pm to 7.00 pm Mondays to Fridays and 8.00 am to 1.30 pm on Saturdays.

The vehicles for which the bus lanes remain available would remain unchanged.

- 3. The general effect of the Waiting and Loading Order would be to further amend the Islington (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Consolidation Order 2004 that in the lengths of streets specified in the Schedules to this Notice, the hours during which the existing prohibition applies on waiting and loading by vehicles would be changed so that they would apply during the specified hours.
