THE A63 TRUNK ROAD (EAST OF PECKFIELD BAR TO BOOT AND SHOE) (DETRUNKING) ORDER 2006

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made the following Order:

An Order under sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980, entitled the A63 Trunk Road (East of Peckfield Bar to Boot and Shoe) (Detrunking) Order 2006, which provides that a length of the A63 Trunk Road shall cease to be a trunk road, and shall be classified as classified roads, as from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies Leeds City Council (who will become the highway authority responsible for the slip roads within their area).

Copies of the Order and the plans referred to in it have been deposited at the offices of the Highways Agency, Major Projects Directorate, City House, PO Box 206, New Station Street, Leeds LS1 4UR, and at Leeds City Council, Civic Hall, Leeds LS1 1UR, where they are open to inspection, free of charge, at all reasonable hours.

Any person aggrieved by an Order mentioned in this notice who desires to question its validity, or the validity of any provision in it, on the ground that:

(a) it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, or

(b) any requirement of that Act or of regulations made under that Act has not been complied with in relation to that Order,

may apply to the High Court within 6 weeks from the date of first publication of this notice. On such an application, the Court may suspend or quash that Order or any provision in it.
