Highways Agency ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A36 TRUNK ROAD (WILTON TO SALISBURY) (50MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2006

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he made this Order on 30 May 2006, coming into force on 10 June 2006, on the A36 Trunk Road in the district of Salisbury, in the county of Wiltshire. The notice of the proposal to make it (Ref HA 028/003/00144) was published in issue no 57708 of *The London Gazette* on 21 July 2005 and the effect of the Order is as described in that notice.

The existing Temporary Order imposing a 40 mph speed limit on this length of the A36 Trunk Road is hereby revoked.

#### THE A1 TRUNK ROAD (GREAT NORTH ROAD, BEDFORDSHIRE TO CAMBRIDGESHIRE) (VARIABLE SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2004 REVOCATION ORDER 2006

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of, and paragraph 27(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on the A1 Trunk Road in Bedfordshire and Cambridgeshire.

The effect of the Order will be to revoke the A1 Trunk Road (Great North Road, Bedfordshire to Cambridgeshire) (Variable Speed Limit) Order 2005/SI 2602, which imposed a 40 or 50 miles per hour speed limit, in conjunction with lane closures, on the A1 Trunk Road:

(a) northbound carriageway between its junctions with the entry slip road from the A1(M) Junction 10 Baldock Services and the exit slip road to the A1(M) Junction 14 Alconbury Interchange,

(b) southbound carriageway between its junctions with the entry slip road from the A1(M) Junction 14 Alconbury Interchange and the exit slip road to the A1(M) Junction 10 Baldock Services, and

(c) slip roads and link roads leading to or from the lengths of northbound and southbound carriageways mentioned above.

### **Highways Agency** ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A5 TRUNK ROAD (LONDON ROAD, DUNSTABLE) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2006

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and 4(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on the A5 Trunk Road in Bedfordshire.

The effect of the Order would be to impose a waiting restriction on the layby adjacent to the A5, London Road:

(a) between points 12.5 metres south and 43.5 metres south of its junction with Oldhill, for a period of 1 hour between 10.00 am and 11.00 am, and

(b) between points 43.5 metres south and 74.5 metres south of its junction with Oldhill, for a period of 1 hour between 2.00 pm and 3.00 pm, Mondays to Fridays.

#### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A453 TRUNK ROAD AND A52 TRUNK ROAD (NOTTINGHAM) (40 MILES PER HOUR AND 50 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2006

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on lengths of the A453 and A52 Trunk Roads and connecting roads, in the City of Nottingham and the county of Nottinghamshire.

The effect of the Order, which comes into force on 12 June 2006, will be to impose:

(a) a 40 miles per hour speed limit on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 below;

(b) a 50 miles per hour speed limit on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 below;

(c) amend The (A52/A6514) Nottingham Ring Road Trunk Road (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1985; and

(d) revoke The A453 Trunk Road (Barton Lane and Clifton Lane, Nottinghamshire) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1995.

The Order imposes new speed limits and also consolidates existing speed limits into a single Order.
