NEW ROADS AND STREET WORKS ACT 1991

NEW ROADS AND STREET WORKS

NOTIFICATION OF SUBSTANTIAL ROADWORKS

In accordance with section 58 of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991, three months' advance notice is hereby given that Transport for London (Highway Authority) intends to carry out substantial works for road purposes.

The streets in which these works will take place are as follows:

A24 London Road, opposite the Superdrug store;

A24 London Road, near the roundabout;

A24 Merantun Way, at the toucan crossing;

A24 Merantun Way, at the pelican crossing;

A24 Colliers Wood High Street, opposite Cavendish Road at the bus stop.

Works are expected to affect the carriageway only.

Works are expected to commence on 15 September 2006 and last for approximately 6 weeks.

Subject to the exemption in the Act and regulations under it, no street works may be expected for a period of 12 months from the completion of the works described in paragraph 5 without the consent of the said Highway Authority/Roads Authority, which shall not be unreasonably withheld.
