Notice is hereby given that F D Todd and Sons Ltd has applied to the Environment Agency for an Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control (IPPC) permit to operate an installation involving the disposal of waste in a landfill receiving more than 10 tonnes of waste in any day or with a total capacity of more than 25,000 tonnes, excluding disposals in landfills taking only inert waste. The installation is located at Knapton Gravel Quarry, East Knapton, Malton, North Yorkshire YO17 8JA, in the district of Ryedale in the county of North Yorkshire.
