THE KINGSTON UPON THAMES (WATTING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (AMENDMENT NO 20/2006) TRAFFIC ORDER 2006

WAITING RESTRICTIONS—KINGSTON, NEW MALDEN & SURBITON

1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames, on 31 July 2006, made the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Order, which will come into force on 7 August 2006, would be to introduce waiting restrictions at the following locations. The restrictions would operate "at any time" (double yellow lines), except in St Matthew's Avenue where they would apply between 10.00 a.m. and 12.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays.

Ditton Road/Mayfair Close, Surbiton, at the junction of Ditton Road and Mayfair Close.

St Matthew's Avenue, Surbiton, outside No 31—to remove the "gap" in the existing restrictions. Please note that the proposal to remove the "gap" outside Nos 29/30, advertised 17 May 2006, will not now be implemented.

Green Lane/Highbury Close, New Malden, at the junction of Green Lane and Highbury Close.

Orme Road, Kingston, outside Nos 23/25, 43/45, 55/57, 69/71 and opposite Nos 104/106 (on the east side) and outside No 22 and Nos 26/28 (on the west side).
