THE EALING (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (AMENDMENT NO) ORDER 200 PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN UXBRIDGE ROAD AT JUNCTIONS WITH MILFORD ROAD AND OAKWOOD ROAD

1. Notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Ealing propose to make the above mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Order would be to introduce double yellow line waiting restrictions applying at any time in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this notice.
