BUS LANES IN FLEET STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Common Council of the City of London on 3 November 2006 made orders under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The effect of the Orders will be to continue in force indefinitely the provisions of an experimental scheme namely the modifications to the operation of the eastbound bus lane and to the restrictions on waiting and loading in Fleet Street, between Ludgate Circus and Fetter Lane. The westbound bus lane in Fleet Street will be removed.

3. A copy of the Orders which will come into operation on 13 November 2006 of a plan showing the affected street during normal office hours until the end of six weeks from the date on which the order was made at the Department of Planning and Transportation, St. Alphage House, Fore Street, London EC2Y 5DH.

4. Copies of the Order may be obtained from the above address or by telephoning 0207 332 1108.

5. Any person desiring to question the validity of the orders or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
