Avenue NW7 to a resident permit parking place in order to provide an improved parking opportunity for resident permit holders in the area.

- 7. The general effect of the Chipping Barnet On-Street Parking Places Order will be to amend the operational periods of dual use permit holders and pay and display parking places on Great North Road and Hadley Green Road, Barnet from Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm, to Monday to Friday 9.30am to 2.30pm and Saturdays 8am to 6.30pm as part of a School Travel Plan, in order to provide parents with a safe area to drop off and collect their children from schools in the local area.
- 8. The general effect of the North Finchley On-Street Parking Places Order and the Waiting and Loading Order will be to reduce the length of the free parking place outside No. 42 Woodside Avenue N12 by 4 metres, and replace this length with at any time waiting restrictions which would prohibit waiting by vehicles at all times. New at any time waiting restrictions will be introduced around the northernmost junction of Woodside Avenue N12 and Little Cedars N12 by upgrading the existing Monday to Friday 2pm to 3pm waiting restrictions. - 2. The general effect of the "Parking Places" Order will be to: (a) reduce the hours of operation of existing parking places from 8.00 a.m. - 6.30 p.m. on Mondays - Saturdays to 10.00 a.m. - 3.00 p.m. on Mondays - Fridays in certain lengths of the streets specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice;
