N humble Address of the Governour, Council, and Affembly of the Island of Jamaica, dated the 31ft of October 1719, having been transmitted hither, has been presented to His Majesty by the Right Honourable James Craggs, Efq; one of His Majefty's Principal Secretaries of State.

Which Address His Majesty was pleased to receive very graciously.

Hague, Feb. 16, N. S. This Evening the Earl of Cadogan, Count Morville, and the Marquess Beretti Landi, met at Prince Maurice's Houfe, (which is kept by the States for the Reception of Ambassadours, and was lent to these Ministers by their High Mightinesses on this Occasion,) and figned the Convention made at Paris the 18th of July 1718. The same Ministers, with Count Windischgratz the Emperour's Ambassadour, have agreed to meet at the fame Houfe To-Morrow, to fign the Treaty of London of the 2d of August 1718. Letters from Dantzick of the 7th of February N. S. tell us, that they had Advice from Warfaw, that Mr. Scot his Britannick Majesty's Minister, arrived there on the 31st of January. The fame Advices from Dantzick relate, that by Letters from Petersbourg of the 22d of January, N. S. they had an Ac-count, that the Czar having relapfed into his old Diftemper the Cholick, was, at the Departure of those Letters, ex-tremely ill: This had given great Uneasines to his Ministers at Dantzick, who were waiting with great Impatience for the next Post from Petersbourg.
