

## Croydon Council

### PROPOSED 'AT ANY TIME' WAITING RESTRICTIONS – VARIOUS LOCATIONS, CROYDON

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council proposes to make Traffic Orders under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Local Government Act 1985.

2. The general effect of the Order would be to introduce waiting restrictions:—

(a) “at any time” throughout the week in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice;

(b) between 8am and 6.30pm on Monday to Saturday inclusive in the length of Cranleigh Close, South Croydon specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice.

3. A copy of the proposed Order and all related documents can be inspected until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Order is made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Order, during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at the Enquiry Counter, “One Stop” Facility, Taberner House, Park Lane, Croydon, Surrey.

5. Persons desiring to object to the proposed Order should send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Order Making Section, Parking Services, Environmental, Cultural and Sports Services, 1st Floor, Davis House, Robert Street, Croydon, CRO 1QQ quoting the reference ECSS/PS/JAA/7/J38 by 14 March 2007.

6. The proposed Order is intended to introduce ‘At any time’ waiting restrictions at various locations and waiting restrictions between 8am and 6.30pm on Monday to Saturday inclusive in a length of Cranleigh Close. The measures are intended to improve safety by providing increased visibility at junctions, prevent obstructive parking and improve access for emergency and public service vehicles.

SCHEDULE 1

**Abbey Road** – both sides, for 10 metres from Sundale Avenue

**Alma Place** – (a) the north-east to south-west arm, the south-east side, for 10 metres either side of the north-west to south-east arm of Alma Place;

(b) the north-west to south-east arm, both sides, for 10 metres from the north-east to south-west arm of Alma Place;

(c) the south-west side, for 5 metres from Earlswood Avenue.

**Ashley Road** – both sides, for 10 metres from Grove Road

**Birchanger Road** – the north-east side, for 10 metres either side of Enmore Road

**Bullrush Close** – (a) the north-west side, for 15 metres from Gloucester Road

(b) the south-east side, from Gloucester Road to a point 4 metres south-east of the party wall of Nos. 216 and 218 Gloucester Road

**Christie Drive** – both sides, from 10 metres from Davidson Road to the party wall of Nos. 17 and 19 Christie Drive

1) for 12 metres from Portland Road

2) for 12 metres from the south-western kerb-line of Clifford Road

(b) the south-east side,

1) for 26 metres from Portland Road

2) for 7 metres from the north-eastern kerb-line of Clifford Road

(c) the north-east side, from the south-eastern kerb-line of Clifford Road to the party wall of Nos. 37 and 39 Clifford Road

(d) the south-west side, from the north-western kerb-line of Clifford Road to a point 20 metres south-east of Carmichael Road

**Earlswood Avenue** – the north-west side, for 5 metres from Alma Place

**Enmore Road** – for 10 metres from Birchanger Road

**Frith Road** – the north-east side, for 10 metres either side of Keeley Road

**Georgia Road** – for 15 metres from Green Lane

**Gloucester Road** – the north-east side, for 10 metres either side of Bullrush Close

**Goldwell Road** – both sides, 10 metres either side of Grove road

**Green Lane** – the north-east side, for 15 metres either side of Georgia Road

**Grove Road**

(a) both sides, for 10 metres either side of Goldwell Road

(b) the south-west side, for 10 metres either side of Ashley Road and Kirklees Road

**Grove Wood Hill** – both sides, for 15 metres from Woodcote Grove Road

**Headley Drive** – the north-west side, for 15 metres from Lodge Lane

**High Street, South Norwood** – the south-east side, outside No. 92 (PH) High Street, South Norwood

**Keeley Road** – both sides, for 10 metres from Frith Road

**Kingsway Avenue** – both sides, for 10 metres from Sundale Avenue

**Kirklees Road** – both sides, for 10 metres from Grove Road

**Kitley Gardens** – (a) both sides, for 10 metres from Sylvan Road

(b) the north-west side, from a point 24 metres south-west of Sylvan Road south-westward for 19 metres

**Pickering Gardens** – both sides, for 13 metres from Christie Drive

**Selhurst Road** – both sides, outside Nos. 235 to 245 and 200 to 212 Selhurst Road

**Station Road, South Norwood** – both sides, adjacent to No. 92 (PH) High Street, South Norwood and outside Nos. 2 to 6 Station Road, South Norwood

**Sundale Avenue** – both sides, for 10 metres south-west of Kingsway Avenue and Abbey Road to 15 metres north-east of Kingsway Avenue and Abbey Road

**Sylvan Road** – the south-west side, for 10 metres either side of Kitley Gardens

**Towpath Way** – both sides, from 10 metres north-west of Davidson Road to the party wall of Nos. 8 and 10 Towpath Way

**Woodcote Grove Road** – the west side, for 10 metres either side of Grove Wood Hill

HILLSIDE RISE/NORTHWOOD WAY, NORTHWOOD

Hillingdon Council gives notice that on 16 February 2007 it made this Order which will:

(a) impose waiting and loading restrictions on the length of road as shown in Schedule 1 to this notice, and

(b) impose waiting restrictions on the lengths of roads as shown in Schedule 2 to this notice.

A copy of the Order which will come into operation on 23 February 2007 can be seen at Yiewsley, Northwood Hills, Ruislip; Oak Farm Libraries and at Level 3 Reception, Civic Centre, Uxbridge during normal office hours, for 6 weeks following the date on which this notice is published. SCHEDULE 1

*Waiting and loading prohibited at any time*  
*York Road, Uxbridge*

(a) The north east side, between the south-eastern kerblines of the entrance to the supermarket and opposite a point 20 metres north-west of the north-western kerblines of George Street.

(b) the south-west side,

(i) From a point 7 metres north-west of the north-western boundary of Friends Meeting House for a distance of 85 metres south-eastwards;

(ii) Between a point 75 metres north-west of the north-western kerblines of George Street and a point 20 metres north-west of said kerblines.
