6. to convert existing dedicated disabled bays to resident parking places ouside 46 Frederick Street; Foster Crt, Royal College Street; 31 Ingham Road and 30 Pandora Road;

7. to convert existing resident parking space to doctor parking space outside no.180 Leighton Road;

8. to introduce a new Business (scheme A) parking place opposite no.19 St.Cross Street and outside 21 Southampton Place.

THE CAMDEN (WAITING & LOADING RESTRICTIONS) (AMENDMENT NO. *173*) ORDER 2007

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Council of the London Borough of Camden propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

The general nature and effect of the Orders will be;-

(i) To introduce double yellow line 'at any time' waiting restrictions at and around all four arms of the junction of Prince of Wales Road/ Malden Road/Malden Crescent, extending approximately 30 metres in all directions.

(ii) To amend the waiting restrictions along Castlehaven Road, between Prince of Wales Road and Hawley Road and adjacent junctions with Castle Road; Clarence Way and Lewis Street to correspond with the two new zebra crossings introduced to the layout.

(iii) To amend the waiting restrictions in Ferdinand Place.

(iv) To introduce double yellow line 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions in West End Lane, west side from northern kerb line of Iverson Road to no.217 West End Lane.

(v) To amend the waiting restrictions in Eversholt Street, west side to operate between 7am to 7pm Mondays to Fridays to correspond with and accommodate the new 16 metre long loading bay outside Hardwick House.

(vi) To amend and shorten the existing resident and motorcycle parking places on the north side of Prince of Wales Road between nos.124 to110 to accommodate the new pedestrian crossing point and junction layout.

(vii) To re-instate a pay & display parking place in Ferdinand Place. (viii) To amend parking place layout in Castlehaven Road between nos. 85-105 to accommodate new zebra crossing layout.

WARPLE WAY - CYCLE EXEMPTION FROM ONE-WAY WORKING

THE EALING (PRESCRIBED ROUTES) (NO. 88) TRAFFIC ORDER 2007

THE EALING (CYCLE LANE) (NO. 10) TRAFFIC ORDER 2007 THE EALING (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (AMENDMENT NO.310) ORDER 2007

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing Council on the 31st May 2007 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985. 2. The general effect of the Orders will be to:

(a) revoke and re-enact the provisions of the Ealing and Hammersmith (Prescribed Routes) Traffic Order 1966 that imposes one way working in a south to north direction in Warple Way (between Cobbold Road and Canham Road) so as to allow pedal cycles to proceed in that length of Warple Way through the cycle lane constructed south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Canham Road and to then continue in a southerly direction towards Cobbold Road;

(b) introduce a cycle lane in Warple Way, at its junction with Canham Road so as to allow pedal cycles to enter Warple way through the cycle lane;

(c) introduce double yellow line waiting restrictions applying at any time in the lengths of Warple Way described in the Schedule to this notice.

3. The Orders, which will come into operation on 4th June 2007, and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders are available for inspection between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive at Mouchel Parkman, 6th Floor, 58 Uxbridge Road, Ealing, London W5 2ST, until the 12th July 2007

4. Any person desiring to question the validity of any of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to any of the Orders may make application for the purpose to the High Court by the 12th July 2007.
