Aberdeen City Mission	A Christian Charity working with those in need and crisis.
Airdrie Music Project	The main objects of the group are to encourage young people in Airdrie and surrounding areas to express themselves through music. The group also provides facilities and equipment for young people.
The Ardler Environment Group	Caring for our local environment.
Seagull Trust Cruises	Free canal cruising in Scotland for disabled people.
Bargeddie Forward	Aims and objectives of the organisation are to provide the village with social or recreational clubs, committees, venues, etc to enhance the village and to bring the community closer together.
Duns and District Amateur Operatic Society	To encourage all ages in the community of Berwickshire to participate in dramatic and operatic arts.
H.O.P.E. (Hospitalfield Organic Produce Enterprise) Trust	A group which works with adults with learning disabilities teaching them gardening skills and producing organic vegetables.
North Lanarkshire Scramble and Quad Bike Club	Recreational biking for young people.
Radio North Angus	The provision of a voluntary-operated independent, local radio station for the county of Angus. It promotes health, welfare, voluntary organisations, educational establishments and the local economy.

Basics Hampshire	Volunteer Doctors who attend Road Traffic Accidents and Major accidents.
Arun Co-ordinated Community Transport	To provide affordable and accessible transport for those unable to use public transport and who would otherwise be isolated in their own homes.
Crawley and Horsham Home-Start	The aim of the group is to provide support to parents with young children who are coping with stressful situations. The idea behind the scheme is that if parents feel that their support needs are being met, they can, in turn, better meet the needs of their children and it is also hoped that the support provided can help to prevent crises developing and the breakdown of family life.
Home-Start Banbury and Chipping Norton	Offers friendship and informal support to parents with young children, so that every child can have a good start in life.
Kintbury Volunteer Group	Provides transport and many other services to residents of Kintbury.
Sir Michael Sobell House	They provide care and help to patients in the hospice.
Swaythling Neighbourhood Centre	The main aim of the group is to manage and maintain a community facility to enable organisations, clubs and local people to use/provide a range of low cost and inclusive activities and central meeting place for the area.
The Archway Foundation	To relieve distress associated with loneliness, provide weekly opportunities for meeting with others in a supportive social setting, offer individual support and help prevent the development of mental health problems.
Hi Kent Volunteer Visiting Scheme	To patiently explain, demonstrate and train deaf and hard of hearing to insert and use their hearing aids, enable to use their aids to the best advantage, provide clinics across Kent to maintain these aids by cleaning, re-tubing, checking batteries and to pick up any problems with the aids at the outset.
