NOTICE OF THE ISSUE OF A SUBMARINE PIPELINE WORKS AUTHORISATION

Except with the consent of the Secretary of State, the 323.9 Millimetre Production pipeline shall only be used to convey Gas and the 88.9 Millimetre pipeline shall only be used to convey Methanol & Corrosion Inhibitor.

The pipelines may be used by the holder and with the holder's agreement, and with the consent of the Secretary of State, by other persons.

ConocoPhillips (U.K.) Limited have been appointed operators of the pipelines.
