

(ii) in receipt of the higher rate of Attendance Allowance for applicants aged 65 or over; or
 (iii) where the applicant does not drive and has appointed a nominated carer to drive for them, the carer is in receipt of the Carer's Allowance award.

3. The general effect of the 'Revocation' Order will be to revoke the existing disabled persons parking places specified in the Schedule to this Notice provided by the Brent (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 2) Order 1994 and the Brent (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 1) Order 2001.

4. A copy of each of the Orders, which will come into operation for the purposes of the placing of traffic signs on 15 June 2007 and for all other purposes on 5 November 2007 and of maps which indicate each length of road to which the Order relates can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Order were made at:-

THE BRENT (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. 265) ORDER 2007

THE BRENT (PRESCRIBED ROUTES) (NO. 7) ORDER 2007

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Brent on 22 October 2007 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, the Parking Acts of 1986 and 1989 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

2. The general effect of the 'Parking Places' Order will be to reduce in length and redefine an existing 4 hour pay and display and resident parking place in association with new development in Grange Road.

3. The general effect of the 'Waiting and Loading Restrictions' Order will be further to amend the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that:-

(a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited at any time in a certain length of Grange Road specified in the Schedule to this Notice;

(b) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place will be prohibited between 11.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m.

throughout the week in a certain length of Grange Road specified in the Schedule to this Notice;

(c) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle will be prohibited unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Brent Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;

(d) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, will be prohibited;

(e) any existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles, the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle or the use of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising in a certain length of Grange Road specified in the Schedule to this Notice, will be revoked.

4. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 3(a) and 3(b) above will not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Blue Badge" will apply.

5. The general effect of the 'Prescribed Routes' Order would be to prohibit vehicles from entering that length of Grange Road from a point 30.00 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Cornwall Gardens north-westward to its north-westernmost extremity.

6. The prohibition referred to in paragraph 5 above would not apply to:-

(a) pedal cycles, or

(b) vehicles when used in the service of the Council of the London Borough of Brent in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or the performance of such duties for the vehicles to enter the prohibited area; or

(c) vehicles being used in connection with the maintenance, improvement, reconstruction, cleansing or lighting of the prohibited street or the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer thereunder or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications network or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign thereon; or

(d) vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency; or

(e) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; or

(f) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway by or on behalf of the Metropolitan Police.

7. A copy of each of the Orders, which will come into operation on 5 November 2007, of the map of the relevant area, of the above-mentioned Order of 1979 (and of the Orders which have amended that Order) can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made at:-

(a) The One Stop Local Office, Brent Town Hall, Forty Lane, Wembley, Middx, HA9 9HX;

(b) The One Stop Local Office, Brent House, 349-357 High Road, Wembley, Middx, HA9 6BZ; and

(c) The One Stop Local Office, Willesden Green Library Centre, High Road, Willesden, NW10 2SU.

Any person desiring to question the validity of either of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to either of the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
