### THE LONDON BOROUGH OF MERTON (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION)(AMENDMENT NO. 264) ORDER 2007 (CONTROLLED ZONES) (PARKING PLACES) (RPN) (NO. 2)ORDER, 2007.

#### RAYNES PARK NORTH

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Merton, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, has made the above mentioned Orders under Sections 6 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Road Traffic Act 1991. The Orders were made on the 24<sup>th</sup> October 2007 and shall become operational on the 10<sup>th</sup> December 2007.

2. The general effect of the Orders will be

- (a) to introduce waiting restrictions operating at the times indicated in the roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice;
- (b) to introduce permit-holder bays in the roads detailed in Schedule 2 to this Notice;
- (c) to introduce shared use pay and display bays in the roads detailed in Schedule 3 to this Notice.

3. Nothing in these Orders will apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.

4. Exemptions to 2(a) above are provided in the Order to permit vehicles to wait

- (a) to enable passengers to board or alight and to load or unload their personal luggage;
- (b) for up to 20 minutes for the purpose of delivering and collecting goods or loading/unloading the vehicle at premises adjacent to the street;
- (c) if they are being used to maintain the road or the services therein or by local authorities or the Post Office in pursuance to statutory powers and duties.

5. A copy of the Orders, plans identifying the areas affected by the Orders and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Orders can be inspected during the Council's normal office hours Mondays to Fridays at the Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden, Surrey.

6. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Act, or that any of the relevant requirements of the Act, or of any relevant regulations made under that Act have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.

#### THE REDBRIDGE (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. 8) ORDER 2007

1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Redbridge, after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, on 21 October 2007, made the above mentioned Orders in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The general effect of the Orders will be to make permanent the restrictions currently in force by means of experimental Orders and which:—

- (a) introduced a Controlled Parking Zone in Foremark Close operative between 8.30 am and 6.30 pm on Monday to Saturdays inclusive and provided residents parking places on certain lengths of Foremark Close.
- (b) imposed waiting restrictions operative at any time on certain lengths of Foremark Close and Manford Way.

3. Residents and business users who are eligible may purchase permits and visitor vouchers at the rates set out below:—

residents permit (first vehicle)	£30.00 each per year
residents permit (additional vehicle)	£50.00 each per year
visitors permits (per book of 10 permits)	£4.00 per book
duplicate/replacement permits	£8.00 each
lost permits	£24.00 each

The permits for the controlled parking zone will only be valid in the zone for which they are issued. The maximum entitlement of residents visitors permits will be 50 per household per month.

4. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 25 October 2007, of the Orders being amended and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Orders, together with documents showing more detailed particulars of the restrictions and plans showing the locations may be inspected between 9.00 am and 4.30 pm Mondays to Fridays (9.30 am to 4.30 pm on Wednesdays), until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, at the Information Centre, Lynton House, 255-259 High Road, Ilford, Essex IG1 1NN.

5. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or of any provisions contained therein on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations
