LITTLE NEW STREET/SHOE LANE – RELOCATION OF DISABLED PERSON'S PARKING

ST. MARY AT HILL – PROHIBITION OF WAITING WHITEFRIARS STREET – POLICE PARKING

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of London propose to make orders under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 2. The effect of the orders would be to:
