- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Brent on 19 November 2007 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, the Parking Acts of 1986 and 1989 and the Road Traffic Act
- 2. The general effect of the "Parking Places Amendment" Orders will be to:-
- (a) create resident parking places in Lonsdale Avenue as specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice following the revocation of the existing dual use and resident parking places in Lonsdale Avenue;
- (b) reduce in length the existing pay and display parking place in Woodside Avenue following the provision of a crossover outside No. 40 Mount Pleasant.
- 3. The general effect of the "Waiting and Loading Restrictions" Order will be further to amend the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that:-
- (a) waiting by vehicles (including waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited between 7.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays in the length of street specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice;
- (b) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited at any time in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 3 to this Notice:
- (c) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited between 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 4 to this Notice;
- (d) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited between 8.15 a.m. and 9.15 a.m. and between 2.30 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the length of street specified in Schedule 5 to this Notice;
- (e) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place will be prohibited between 11.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. throughout the week in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 3, between 11.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 4 and between 2.30 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays in the length of street specified in Schedule 5 to this Notice;
- (f) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle will be prohibited (except on Sundays in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 3) unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Brent Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;
- (g) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising will be prohibited;
- (h) any existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles, the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle or the use of any vehicle or animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising in the lengths of streets specified in Schedules 2, 3, 4 and 5 to this Notice will be revoked.
- 4. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 3(a) to 3(e) above will not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption

relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Blue Badge" will apply.
