

- (i) from the north-western kerb-line of Compton Avenue, the south-west arm to south-east arm, to a point 2.00 metres north-west of the south-eastern wall of No. 36 Compton Avenue;
- (ii) from a point 5.00 metres north-west of Nos. 55 and 57 Compton Avenue to a point 8.50 metres south-east of Nos. 59 and 61 Compton Avenue;
- (iii) from Nos. 59 and 61 Compton Avenue to its north-westernmost extremity;

(b) the south-west side

- (i) from the south-eastern kerb-line of Compton Avenue, the south-west arm to south-east arm, to a point 2.00 metres north-west of the south-eastern wall of No. 36 Compton Avenue;
- (ii) from Nos. 59 and 61 Compton Avenue to its north-westernmost extremity.

COMPTON AVENUE, the south-west arm to south-east arm

(a) the north-east and north-west sides

- (i) from a point 7.00 metres south-east Hastings Close to a point 7.00 metres north-west Hastings Close;
- (ii) from a point 10.00 metres north-east Chilcott Close to point 10.00 metres south-west of Chilcott Close;
- (iii) from a point opposite the south-western wall of No. 22 Compton Avenue to the north-eastern kerb-line of Compton Avenue, the south-western arm;

(b) the south-east and south-west sides

- (i) from Repton Avenue to Nos. 6 and 8 Compton Avenue;
- (ii) from a point 1.75 metres north-east of Nos. 28 and 30 Compton Avenue to the south-western kerb-line of Compton Avenue, the south-western arm.

CLIFTON AVENUE, the south-east side, from a point 10.00 metres north-east of Stanley Road to a point 10.00 metres south-west of Stanley Road.

HARRINGTON CLOSE, from the northern kerb-line of Lawrence Way northward for 10.00 metres.

JESMOND AVENUE, the north-west side, from a point 10.00 metres north-east of Stanley Road to a point 10.00 metres south-west of Stanley Road.

HARROWDENE ROAD, the east side, from 10.00 metres south of Barley Close to 10.00 metres north of Barley Close.

HASTINGS CLOSE

- (a) from Compton Avenue north-eastward for 7.00 metres;
- (b) the north-east and south-east sides, from a point 1.50 metres north-west of Nos. 27 and 29 Hastings Close to a point 3.00 metres south-west of the south-western wall of No. 29 Hastings Close;
- (c) the north-west and south-west sides from a point 1.50 metres north-west of Nos. 16 and 18 Hastings Close to a point 1.50 metres south-west of Nos. 22 and 24 Hastings Close.

LAWRENCE WAY, the north and north-east sides, from a point 10.00 metres south-east of Harrington Close to a point 12.00 metres west of Harrington Close.

MEADOWBANK ROAD, the south-east side, from Nos. 46 and 48 Meadowbank Road to a point 3.00 metres south-west of Nos. 49 and 51 Meadowbank Road.

NEASDEN LANE NORTH, the north-east side, from a point 2.70 metres north-west of Nos. 386 and 388 Neasden Lane North to a point 7.10 metres south-east of Nos. 390 / 392 and 394 / 396 Neasden Lane North.

NEELD CRESCENT, the north-west side, from a point 5.20 metres north-east of the south-western boundary of No. 2 Vivian Avenue to a point 4.20 metres north-east of the south-western boundary of No. 21 Neeld Crescent.

STANLEY ROAD

- (a) from Clifton Avenue south-eastward for 10.00 metres;
- (b) from Jesmond Avenue north-westward for 10.00 metres.

SCHEDULE 4

Waiting restrictions (8.00 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive)

GRAND AVENUE, the north-east side, from a point 10.00 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Neeld Crescent to a point 6.00 metres south-east of Nos. 23 and 25 Grand Avenue.

NEELD CRESCENT, the south-east side

- (a) from a point 5.20 metres north-east of the south-western boundary of No. 2 Vivian Avenue to a point 11.00 metres south-west of Grand Avenue;
- (b) from a point 11.00 metres north-east of Grand Avenue to a point 13.00 metres south-west of Oakington Manor Drive.

SCHEDULE 5

Waiting restrictions (8.15 a.m. to 9.15 a.m. and 2.30 p.m. to 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive)

LAWRENCE WAY, the north-east side, from a point 11.70 metres north-west of Quainton Street to a point 10.00 metres south-east of Harrington Close. (397114)

THE BRENT (MUHARRAM AND RAMADAN) (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS) (NO.) ORDER 200

THE BRENT (MUHARRAM AND RAMADAN) (PARKING PLACES) (NO.) ORDER 200

2. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Brent propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, the Parking Acts of 1986 and 1989 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

3. The general effect of the:-

(A) "Waiting and Loading Restriction" Order would be to apply the provisions of the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that during the Islamic periods of Muharram and Ramadan:-

- (i) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited so that they would apply between 8.30 a.m. and 10.00 p.m. in certain lengths of the streets specified in the Schedule to this Notice;
- (ii) waiting by vehicles (for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place would be prohibited between 11.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. in the lengths of streets referred to in (i) above;
- (iii) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle would be prohibited unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Brent Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;
- (iv) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, would be prohibited;
- (v) any existing restrictions in the lengths of streets referred to in subparagraph (i) above would be revoked;

(B) "Parking Places" Order would be, during the Islamic periods of Muharram and Ramadan, to:-

- (i) revoke certain parking places in Chevening Road;
- (ii) change the hours of operation of the parking places in certain lengths of the streets specified in the Schedule to this Notice so that they would operate between 8.30 a.m. and 10.00 p.m.

4. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2(A) (i) and (ii) above would not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Blue Badge" would apply.

5. The prohibitions and requirements referred to in paragraph 2(B) above would not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in respect of anything done in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway by or on behalf of the Metropolitan Police.

6. A copy of each of the proposed Orders, of a map of the relevant area, of the relevant Orders of 1979 and 2004 (and of the Orders which have amended those Orders) and of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the expiration of a period of 21 days from the date on which this Notice is published at:-
