NEW ROADS AND STREET WORKS ACT 1991, SECTION 58 NOTICE OF SUBSTANTIAL WORKS FOR ROAD PURPOSES

1. Three months advance notice is hereby given that Transport for London, intends to carry out substantial works for road purposes.
2. The road in which these works will take place are:

(a) the A11 Mile End Road between Stepney Green to White Horse Lane and between No's 373 and 497;
(b) the A11 Mile End Road outside Stepney Green Tube Station, and A13 Commercial Road between Butcher Row and Boulcott Street in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets.

3. TfL ref SPST-TO-S58/2008/015.

4. Work is expected to affect the carriageway and footway.

5. Work is expected to commence on 5 July 2008.

6. Work is expected to be completed on 30 December 2008.

7. The works will include the following:

(a) complete carriageway resurfacing along with footway works between Stepney Green to White Horse Lane and between No's 373 and 497.
(b) complete footway replacement outside Stepney Green Tube Station, and A13 Commercial Road between Butcher Row and Boulcott Street.

8. Subject to the exemptions in the Act and Regulations under it, no street works may be executed for a period of 12 months from completion of the works described in paragraph 7 without consent of Transport for London, which shall not be unreasonably withheld.

ALTERATION TO LOADING RESTRICTIONS IN WOOD STREET/

ALTERATION TO PARKING FACILITIES IN VARIOUS STREETS

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of London on 4 April 2008 made orders under section 6 and section 45 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The effect of the Orders will be to:

(a) to change the hours during which the existing restriction on loading by vehicles on the west side of Wood Street either side of Monkwell Square so that they apply at any time;

(b) convert existing doctor parking bays in Brushfield Street, Finsbury Circus and Lloyds Avenue into Disabled persons parking bays. The bays would be free of charge and available for use at any time for City "Red" badge holders. Other badge holders will be limited to three hours maximum stay on Mondays to Fridays;

(c) revoke a Disabled persons parking bays in Salters Hall Court; and
(d) remove a Pay and Display parking bay at the northern end of Mincing Lane and on the south side of Great Tower Street.

3. A copy of each of the orders, which will come into operation on 14 April 2008 and of a plan showing the affected streets can be inspected during normal office hours on Monday to Fridays inclusive until the end of six weeks from the date on which the orders were made at the Department of Planning and Transportation, St.Alphage House, Fore Street, London, EC2Y 5DA.

SOUTHWARK BRIDGE - MANDATORY CYCLE LANES

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of London in pursuance of arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 on 4 April 2008, made an order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The effect of the Order will be to create a mandatory northbound and southbound cycle lane across Southwark Bridge and from which (subject to certain exemptions) all vehicles except pedal cycles will be prohibited.

3.
