

AYLESTONE AVENUE AREA THE BRENT (PARKING PLACES) (NO. 9, 2003) (AMENDMENT

NO.) ORDER 200 THE BRENT (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING OUTSIDE SCHOOLS) (REVOCATION NO.) TRAFFIC ORDER 200 THE BRENT (SPEED LIMITS) (NO.) TRAFFIC ORDER 200 THE BRENT (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO.) ORDER 200

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Brent propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49, 84 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, the Parking Acts of 1986 and 1989 and the Traffic Management Act 2004.

2. The general effect of the 'Parking Places Amendment' Order would be to revoke and to reduce in length the existing dual use and resident parking places in Aylestone Avenue, Christchurch Avenue, Dundonald Road, Mount Pleasant Road, Okehampton Road, The Avenue and Tiverton Road following the provision of pedestrian crossings, pedestrian refuges and the improvement on safety of the junctions.

3. The general effect of the 'Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools' Order would be to revoke existing school entrance markings in Christchurch Avenue, Kilburn, the north-west side, from 21.00 metres south-west of No. 65 Christchurch Avenue south-westward for 25.56 metres.

4. The general effect of the 'Speed Limit' Order will be to impose a maximum speed limit of 20 miles per hour in certain lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice.
5. The general effect of the 'Waiting and Limit's Department's period.

5. The general effect of the 'Waiting and Loading Restrictions'Order would be further to amend the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that:-

(a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be changed from between 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive to 'at any time' in certain lengths of Aylestone Avenue, Dundonald Road, Mount Pleasant Road, Okehampton Road and Tiverton Road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice;

(b) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place would be prohibited between 11.00 a.m. and 6.30

p.m. throughout the week in certain lengths of Aylestone Avenue, Dundonald Road, Mount Pleasant Road, Okehampton Road and Tiverton Road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice.

6. A copy of each of the proposed Orders, of a map of the relevant area, of the relevant Orders of 1979 and 2003 (and of the Orders which have previously amended those Orders) and of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the expiration of a period of 21 days from the date on which this Notice is published at:—-

(b) The One Stop Local Office, Brent House, 349-357 High Road, Wembley, Middx, HA9 6BZ.

SCHEDULE 1

Speed Limits

Aylestone Avenue; Christchurch Avenue which lies between the northeastern kerb-line of Aylestone Avenue and the south-western kerb-line of Brondesbury Park; Chudleigh Road; Crediton Road; Dundonald Road; Hanover Road; Henley Road; Manor House Drive, Milverton Road; Mount Pleasant Road; Okehampton Road; The Avenue which lies between the north-eastern kerb-line of Tiverton Road and the south-western kerb-line of Brondesbury Park; Tiverton Road; and Wrentham Road.

SCHEDULE 2

Waiting restrictions (At any time)

Aylestone Avenue, from a point 9.50 metres north-west of The Avenue north-westward for 6.00 metres.

Dundonald Road, the north-east side, from a point 10.00 metres southeast of Okehampton Road south-eastward for a distance of 5.00 metres.

Mount Pleasant Road, the south-west side, from a point 10.00 metres north-west of Okehampton Road north-westward for a distance of 5.00 metres.

Okehampton Road

(a) the north-west side, from a point 7.50 metres north-east of Nos.
75 and 77 Okehampton Road to Nos. 62 and 64 Okehampton Road;
(b) the south-east side, from Nos. 64 and 66 Okehampton Road to Nos. 62 and 64 Okehampton Road.

Tiverton Road

(a) the north-east side, from a point 7.50 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Okehampton Road south-eastward for a distance of 5.00 metres;

(b) the south-west side, from a point 10.00 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Okehampton Road to a point 15.20 metres north-west of No. 24 Tiverton Road and No. 66 Okehampton Road. (517903)
