Heathrow Airport Limited SOUTHAMPTON ROAD

TEMPORARY (ONE WAY WORKING) TRAFFIC ORDER 2008

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Heathrow Airport Limited intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), and all other enabling powers in order to facilitate maintenance works.
- 2. The general effect of the Order will be to:
- (a) Create a one way system going anti-clockwise through the cargo lanes north of Southampton Road
- (b) Vehicles travelling along Southampton Road will be prohibited from proceeding west between the its junction with the eastern lane of Shoreham Road and its junction with the western lane of Shoreham Road
- 3. The Order shall have effect from 19/05/08 to 30/06/08 or until said works are complete, whichever is sooner.
- 4. A copy of the Order may be inspected during normal office hours, Monday to Friday at First and Last Impressions, D'Albiac House, Heathrow Airport, Middlesex, UB3 5AP.
- 5. Any person desiring to question the validity of any of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not

within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to any of the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
