ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A65 TRUNK ROAD (HELLIFIELD) (40 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2008

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on 19 May 2008 she has made an Order under Sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which comes into force on 6 June 2008.

THE HAMMERSMITH AND FULHAM (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (CONSOLIDATION) AMENDMENT (NO. 28) ORDER 2008

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Council of the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham, on 28th May 2008 made the above mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic Act 1991 and the local Government Act 1985.
