AMENDMENTS TO SOUTHALL (AREA 5) CPZ ZONE LL

THE EALING (SOUTHALL AREA 5) (RESIDENTS PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2008

THE EALING (FREE PARKING PLACES) (NO. 2) (AMENDMENT NO. 101) ORDER 2008

THE EALING (FREE PARKING PLACES) (NO. 4) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 2008

THE EALING (FREE PARKING PLACES) (DISABLED PERSONS) (SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (AMENDMENT NO. 84) ORDER 2008

THE EALING (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (AMENDMENT NO. 357) ORDER 2008

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing Council, on the 20th August 2008 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
2. The general effect of the Ealing (Southall Area 5) (Residents Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2008 will be:
 - (a) to introduce additional lengths of parking places for the use by residents, their visitors and business users in lengths of Adelaide Road, Talbot Road and Witley Gardens;
 - (b) to remove lengths of parking places in Lea Road, Montague Road, Regina Road and Witley Gardens.
3. The general effect of the Ealing (Free Parking Places) (No. 2) (Amendment No. 101) Order 2008 will be to introduce limited time free parking places where parking by vehicles during the controlled hours will be limited to a maximum stay of 1 hour with no return by the same vehicle to the same parking place for a period of one hour in Albert Road, Montague Road and Talbot Road. The order also removes lengths of free parking place in Adelaide Road and Regina Road.
4. The general effect of the Ealing (Free Parking Places) (No. 4) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2008 will be to introduce limited time free parking places where parking by vehicles during the controlled hours will be limited to one hour with no return by the same vehicle to the same parking place for a period of one hour and where vehicles displaying a valid Southall Area 5 LL zone resident permit will be able to use the bays without limit of time in lengths of Ellison Gardens.
5. The general effect of the Ealing (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. 357) Order 2008 will be to amend existing waiting restrictions in lengths of Adelaide Road, Regina Road and Witley Gardens to apply at any time and to introduce a new length of waiting restriction applying at any time on the east side of Lea Road.

6. The general effect of the Ealing (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (Amendment No.84) Order 2008 will be to relocate free parking places for vehicles displaying a disabled person's blue badge parking permit in certain lengths of Williams Road.
7. Copies of the Orders, which will come into force on 26th August 2008 and of other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, can be inspected between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Monday to Fridays inclusive until the 1 October 2008 at Mouchel Limited, 6th Floor, 58 Uxbridge Road, Ealing, London W5 2ST.
8. Any person desiring to question the validity of any of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any relevant requirements thereof or any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to any of the Orders may make application for the purpose to the High Court by the 1st October 2008.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing on the 20th August 2008 made the above mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Waiting Restriction Order will be to remove the "at any time" waiting restriction in Newark Crescent outside Nos. 52 and 54.
3. The general effect of the Disabled Persons Parking Place Order will be to introduce a free parking place for vehicles displaying a disabled person's blue badge parking permit without limit on time in Buckingham Avenue outside Nos. 163 to 168.
4. The general effect of the Ambulance Parking Places Order will be to formalise the 24 hour parking place for marked ambulance service vehicles in Buckingham Avenue outside Nos. 127 to 131.
5. The Orders, which will come into operation on 26th August 2008, other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, are available for inspection during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at Mouchel Limited, 6th Floor, 58 Uxbridge Road, Ealing, London W5 2ST, until the 1st October 2008.

Any person desiring to question the validity of any of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any relevant requirements thereof or any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to any of the
