(AMENDMENT NO. 7) ORDER 2008

DISABLED PERSONS PARKING BAYS

VARIOUS STREETS THROUGHOUT THE BOROUGH

(REFERENCE 81/08)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on the 6 October 2008 made the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The principal objective of the Order is to introduce a number of parking places for disabled persons where a high level of parking made reasonable means of access difficult and to discontinue a number of similar parking places previously provided where the demand for such bays no longer exists.

3. The Order will introduce a parking bay for disabled persons' vehicles, operating "at any time" at the following locations:-

- (a) outside No 63 Campbell Road, Twickenham;
- (b) outside No 139 Kneller Road, Whitton;
- (c) outside No 82 Madrid Road, Barnes;
- (d) outside No 25 Paynesfield Avenue, Sheen;
- (e) outside No 59 Rosecroft Gardens, Twickenham;
- (f) outside No 9 Sutherland Gardens; and
- (g) outside No 29 Trehern Road, Sheen.

4. The Order will revoke the existing parking bays for disabled persons vehicles at the following locations:-

- (a) outside No 11 The Barons, Twickenham
- (b) outside No 9 The Hermitage, Barnes;
- (c) outside No 33 Houblon Road, Richmond;
- (d) outside No 5 Martindale, Sheen;
- (e) outside No 111 Manor Grove, Richmond;
- (f) outside No 21 Mead Road, Ham
- (g) outside No 27 Trehern Road, Sheen; and
- (h) outside No 2 White Hart Lane, Barnes.

5. The Council has deferred making a decision in respect of proposals to introduce new bays in Bushy Park Road, Teddington; Gladstone Avenue, Twickenham; and Kendrey Gardens, Twickenham; and in respect of the proposals to revoke existing bays in Albert Road, Teddington; Bushwood Road, Kew; Derby Road, Sheen; Haliburton Road, Isleworth; Observatory Road, Sheen; Shalstone Road, Mortlake; and Stretton Road, Ham, notice of which was given on 18 July 2008.

- (i) the Civic Centre (Planning Reception, ground floor) 44 York Street, Twickenham TW1 3BZ between 9.15am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays, except for Bank and other public holidays.

8. Persons wishing to question the validity of this Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the 1984 Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with that person

may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

WHITE HART LANE, BARNES

(REFERENCE 79/08)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames propose to make the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Traffic Management Act 2004.

2. The general effect of the Order will be to introduce a new loading place in White Hart Lane, Barnes as detailed in the Schedule to this notice. The loading place will be for the use of goods vehicles only, during the times specified in the Schedule.
