Road Traffic Acts

The Highways Agency ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A550 AND A494 TRUNK ROADS (WOODBANK JUNCTION) (50 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 200*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A550 and A494 Trunk Roads at Woodbank in the City of Chester in the County of Cheshire.

The Order, if made as proposed, will impose a 50 miles per hour speed limit on the following sections of carriageway;

- 1. the northbound carriageway of the A550 Trunk Road from a point 295 metres north of the northern bridge parapet of the northern bridge of Deeside Park Junction, to a point 180 metres north of the junction with Woodbank Lane,
- 2. the southbound carriageway of the A550 Trunk Road from a point 180 metres north of the junction with Woodbank Lane to a point 480 metres south of the junction with Woodbank Lane,
- 3. the A550 Trunk Road from a point 350 metres north of the junction with the unclassified road to Shotwick, to a point 180 metres north of the junction with Woodbank Lane, and

4. the link road leading from the northbound carriageway of the A550 Trunk Road at Woodbank Junction, to the eastbound carriageway of the A494 Trunk Road from a point on the A550 Trunk Road 65 metres south of the exit from the property at Hill View, to a point on the A494 Trunk Road 160 metres east of the junction with Woodbank Lane.

The speed limit will not apply to vehicles being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform.
