##### NOTICE CONCERNING A SCHEME UNDER SECTION 106(3) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

##### THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF CARDIFF (RIVER ELY CROSSING) SCHEME 2008

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of the City and County of Cardiff has made the County Council of the City and County of Cardiff (River Ely Crossing) Scheme 2008 under section 106(3) of the Highways Act 1980. It has submitted this Scheme to the Welsh Ministers for confirmation and, if confirmed, the Scheme will authorise the County Council of the City and County of Cardiff to construct a bridge over the navigable waters of the River Ely in Cardiff Bay as part of the highway which it is proposing to construct from Watkiss Way and the Bay Edge Walkway at the International Sports Village Site on the north eastern side of the River Ely to the existing cycleway on the south western Penarth side.

A copy of the Scheme and the accompanying plans may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the offices of the County Council of the City

and County of Cardiff, County Hall, Atlantic Wharf, Cardiff, CF10 4UW.

Any objection to the Scheme must be made in writing to the Planning Inspectorate, Crown Buildings, Cathays Park, Cardiff, CF10 3NQ before 20 December, 2008 and should state the title of the scheme, the ground of objection and the objector's address and interests in the land.

THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR TRANSPORT hereby gives notice that he made these Orders under sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 82(2) and 83(1), of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on 27 October 2008, coming into force on 10 November 2008, on the A27 Trunk Road between Southerham roundabout and east and south of Beddingham roundabout, south east of Lewes in the District of Lewes in the County of East Sussex.
