##### A. THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HOUNSLOW (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO.\*\*) ORDER 20\*\*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Hounslow proposes to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 32, 35 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

The general effect of the Parking Places Amendment Order would be to further amend The London Borough of Hounslow (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1987 to include a new off-street parking place accessed from High Street, Brentford and the scale of charges for that parking place, as specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

#### REVISIONS TO BUS LANES - RICHMOND ROAD, KINGSTON

##### THE KINGSTON UPON THAMES (BUS PRIORITY) (AMENDMENT NO. 7) TRAFFIC ORDER 2009

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames on 20th April 2009 made the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.

2. The general effect of the Order, which will come into operation on 27th April 2009, will be to:-

(a) revise the operational hours of the southbound bus lanes on the east side of Richmond Road, to apply between 7.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. throughout the week;

(b) extend the length of the southbound bus lane which lies between East Road and Acre Road by approximately 19 metres southward (outside Nos. 54 to 60 Richmond Road);

(c) shorten the length of the southbound bus lane which lies between Acre Road and Cowleaze Road by approximately 25 metres at its southern end (to terminate at the northern kerb-line of Cowleaze Road).

##### RED LION ROAD, SURBITON (AND ADJACENT SIDE ROADS)

##### THE KINGSTON UPON THAMES (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. 51) TRAFFIC ORDER 2009

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames on 20th April 2009 made the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985:

2. The general effect of the Order, which will come into force on 27th April 2009, will be, in connection with highway improvements in Red Lion Road and the provision of a pedestrian "zebra" crossing outside Tolworth Hospital, to:

(a) introduce double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions in lengths of Red Lion Road and adjacent side roads;

(b) introduce single yellow line waiting restrictions (operating between 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays) outside Nos. 135 to 139 Red Lion Road.

A full description of the extent of the restrictions was given in the Notice of Proposals published 16th January 2009 in the *Surrey Comet* and *London Gazette*.
