THE BARNET (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (AMENDMENT NO. 22) TRAFFIC **ORDER 2009**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet have made on 11th June 2009 the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49, 51 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The general effect of the above Orders will be to prevent obstructive parking near to the junction of Bell Lane and Alexandra Road by introducing At Any Time waiting restrictions, but also to introduce short-term pay and display parking places on Alexandra Road NW4 in order to provide additional parking facilities to motorists wishing to visit local shops and amenities, as the current situation of parked vehicles all day prevents those wishing to visit local shops and amenities. This has subsequently had a negative effect on the trade of local businesses which rely on passing trade.

The pay and display parking will operate between 9am and 6pm, Mondays to Saturdays, and the fees will be:-

Up to 20 minutes	£0.20
Up to 40 minutes	£0.40
Up to 1 hour	£0.60

The maximum stay permissible will be 1 hour.
