NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Brent on 29 June 2009 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, the Parking Acts of 1986 and 1989 and the Traffic Management Act 2004.
- 2. The general effect of the 'Parking Places' Order will be:
- (a) to revoke and reduce in length the existing pay and display parking places in Montrose Crescent and Union Road;
- (b) designate parking places that will operate between 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays in Station Grove specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice;
- (c) specify that:
- (i) each parking place may be used, subject to the provisions of the Order, for the leaving during the permitted hours of such vehicles as are passenger vehicles, goods carrying vehicles, motor cycles or invalid carriages displaying a valid parking ticket;
 (ii) the maximum initial period for which a vehicle, displaying a valid
- parking ticket may be left during the permitted hours in the parking places will be 2 hours;

- (c) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle will be prohibited unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Brent Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;
